



New Treasurer Mails Real Estate Tax Bills

ROCK ISLAND-- Real estate tax bills have been mailed, and property owners should expect to see them in their mail boxes as early as this weekend, according to the new Rock Island County Treasurer, Nick Camlin. The tax billing is part of his responsibilities as County Collector, which takes in all payments for each of the 107 taxing bodies within and including Rock Island County. "This week we began mailing bills for 63,730 parcels of property, in the total amount of \$276,354,325.08, as levied by each layer of government within Rock Island County," said Camlin. Taxpayers who own more than one property may receive multiple bills within one envelope. Each tax bill comes with four tear-off stubs for each of the four installment due dates.

Due Dates for the 2022 Real Estate Taxes, payable in 2023 are as follows:

- 1st Installment: Wednesday, June 7, 2023.
- 2nd Installment: Monday, August 7, 2023.
- 3rd Installment: Thursday, September 7, 2023.
- 4th Installment: Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

Property owners are still responsible for paying taxes, even if, for whatever reason, the bill is not received. Property owners who do not receive a bill should call the Treasurer's Office at once, 309-558-3510. State law requires at least the first installment to be paid by June 7, 2023, to avoid penalty interest, the Collector will accept mailed payments postmarked on or before June 7, 2023, as timely. Payments made or received with a postmark after June 7, 2023, will be subject to penalty interest at a rate of 1.5% per month, or any part of a month, as required by state law.

The County Collector offers many options for making real estate tax payments, including expanded credit/debit card services in-person. Our website, www.rockislandcountyil.gov has full details for all of the following payment methods, as well as the back of the tax bill:

- By mail, including the stub(s) for which you are paying; check made payable to the County Collector.
- At our office, 1504 3rd Avenue, Rock Island, IL 61201. Now accepting in-person credit/debit card payments (processing fees up to 2.45% apply).
- Drive-up Drop Box in the alley/parking lot behind the County Office Building.
- Online by credit/debit card (processing fees up to 2.45% apply) or e-check (\$1.00 flat processing fee applies).
- Dial 1-855-965-4400 and pay using e-check, debit or credit card (processing fees apply).

For all payments, please have your stubs ready to reference the Property Identification Number (PIN), to ensure accurate and smooth transactions.
